

Piano concert in the Łazienki Park, next to Chopin's monument, Sunday, 4 pm

For over 6 decades, every Summer Sunday there are open-air piano concerts given to the public in the Łazienki Park, near the famous monument to Frederic Chopin. The talented performers from all over the whole world play for the public gathered around the monument of Polish most famous composer. The event is free of charge, open to anyone who loves classic music, no bookings whatsoever. The audience may sit on the grass, enjoy the music and beautiful surroundings. The performance lasts for about one hour.

In short: for those who visit Warsaw on Sunday, or Varsavians, this is A MUST.

Why this very performance? Because when it ends, you may walk from the Łazienki Park to the conference venue. The distance is only 20 – 25 minutes away walking, so the timing is perfect: straight from the concert you can go to the venue, register at the registration desk, and soon enjoy the welcome reception.

There will be a young man with the conference logo waiting for the participants near the park gate in front of the Chopin's monument. He will show you the way to the venue.

You can get to the vicinity of the event by public transport: bus lines 116, 166 and 180 stop just next to the park gate ("Łazienki Królewskie" stop). Alternatively, you can take a 700 metres walk from Aleja Armii Ludowej, bus lines 138, 143, 151, 182, 187, 188, 502, 514, 520, 523, 525. Disembark at the "Plac Na Rozdrożu" stop.

Last, but not least:

DO NOT FORGET TO TAKE A BOTTLE OF WATER. IT WILL BE HOT, SO AVOID DEHYDRATION!

There is a limited amount of shaded area around the monument.
